



## What to expect at your appointment with the hearing instrument specialist:

There are four main procedures that will be completed during your visit.

- 1) Case History
- 2) Otoscopy
- 3) Audiometry
- 4) Counseling

**Case History.** Your appointment will begin with a case history. During this time the hearing instrument specialist will ask you questions about your hearing, noise exposure, communication issues, and medically related issues such as tinnitus and dizziness.

**Otoscopy.** The hearing instrument specialist will check for excessive ear wax, blockages, or any problems with your ear canal/eardrum which may require further evaluation by your primary physician.

**Audiometry.** Next, a comprehensive audiometric evaluation will be performed. This evaluation helps determine the type and degree of hearing loss.

**Counseling.** Upon completion of all tests, the hearing instrument specialist will sit down with you and explain the results. At this time, appropriate referrals and/or recommendations will be made.
